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### **ASM Elects First Female President, Announces Board of Directors for 2008-2010 Term**

BOSTON – On November 13, 2008, the Associated Subcontractors of Massachusetts (ASM) elected a new President and Board of Directors for the 2008-2010 term. The elections were held at the John F.
