## With Lieutenant Governor Tim Murray

Throughout his public career, Tim Murray has tackled the tough challenges of economic development, improving public education, protecting the environment and making government more responsive.

Prior to his 2006 election as Lieutenant Governor, Tim served for three terms as mayor of Worcester, where he set the stage for \$1 billion of new economic development projects that are transforming the city. As mayor, Tim also helped make the city's schools among the best urban school systems in the nation.

As Lieutenant Governor, Tim works closely with Governor Patrick on the important issues facing the Commonwealth. He chairs the Governor's Council and five other advisory councils dealing with social and human service issues, homelessness and housing, veterans services and more. Tim is also the Administration's liaison to cities and towns, and chairs the Municipal Cabinet of six agency heads, that seeks to assist municipalities in the areas of technology, civil service, health insurance, purchasing, capital asset management and transportation.

A Worcester native, Tim is a graduate of Fordham University and the Western New England College School of Law, and former partner in the Worcester firm of Tattan, Leonard and Murray. Prior to his elective service, Tim was active for many years in a wide range of community initiatives and served on the boards of the Worcester Public Library, Worcester Historical Museum, the Worcester Community Action Council, and Preservation Worcester. He lives in Worcester with his wife Tammy (Sullivan), and their two daughters.
